## Henk G. Schmidt



Henk G. Schmidt is a professor of psychology at Erasmus University's faculty of social sciences and founding dean of its problem-based psychology curriculum. Presently, he is the Vice-Chancellor ("Rector Magnificus") of Erasmus University, a top-hundred Dutch University. Previously, Schmidt held academic positions as professor of cognitive psychology, faculty of psychology, Maastricht University, and as professor of health professions education at the same university. His research areas of interest are learning and memory, and he has published on problem-based learning, long-term memory, and the development of expertise in medicine.
